#6 Goulasch Suppe ~ \$6.99 (Goulasch Stew)

Rich and hearty blend of tender beef, bacon, potatoes, and tomatoes. Seasoned with warming spices creating the mouth watering stew. Served with a fresh baked German Kaiser roll.



#7 Kartoffel Puffer ~ \$4.99 (Potato Pancakes)

3 homemade golden fried pancakes made from grated potatoes and lightly seasoned. Served with sour cream or applesauce on the side for dipping.

#8 Hühner Nudelsuppe ~ \$4.99 (Chicken Noodle Soup)

Chicken noodle soup with fresh chicken chunks and fine noodles. Served with a fresh baked German Kaiser roll.



#9 Bayrische Brezel ~ \$5.99 (Bavarian Pretzel)

A large Bavarian soft pretzel served with spicy mustard.

#10 Schwälische Brezel ~ \$3.99 (Schwalish Pretzel)

A warm smaller soft pretzel similar to that of the Bavarian pretzel with a little more salty flavor.
